

Costa Navarino Bars & Restaurants

The Westin & Romanos Hotels are seamlessly blended into the resort which has the Agora at the centre of the resort. The Agora has a wide variety of restaurants; reservations in advance are recommended to guarantee your preferred choice of restaurant, at the time you desire.

Morias: Breakfast for Westin Hotel guests is served at Morias from 6.30 am – 10am. In the evening the restaurant is a relaxed buffet style dining experience with a different proposition of diverse offerings, from Greek and International cuisines.

Pero: Breakfast for Romanos guests is served in Pero from 6.30 am to 10 am, where freshly squeezed locally grown oranges and the extensive buffet will get your day off to the perfect start.

Anax Lounge: As day gently slips into night, soak up the sights and sounds of Costa Navarino from the Anax Terrace, with panoramic sunset views of the Ionian Sea. Enjoy spectacular cocktails and gins from the award-winning mixologist and a vast selection of Greek and International wines and beers.

Da Luigi: From the Alps to Sicily the creativity and diversity of Italian cuisine is vividly portrayed at Da Luigi with a la carte selections and traditional pizzas. Da Luigi is a large open-air restaurant, reminiscent of dining in the famous St Mark's Square.

Flame: Flame restaurant is an outdoor terrace overlooking the 18th green on the Dunes Course and specialises in expertly cooked meat dishes, prepared from the finest quality, locally sourced meat.

Barbouni: A unique beachside lunch spot to savour freshly caught fish and delicious dishes by the crystal-clear waters of the Ionian Sea. Named after the Greek word for Red Mullet this Mediterranean delicacy could be on the menu as catch of the day. Barbouni is not open at night as the beach is a nesting site for native turtles.

1827 Lounge Bar: Enjoy sunset views of the Ionian Sea and sample the delicious menu and speciality cocktails, wines and beers.

Onuki: Exceptional Japanese tastes and recipes in a cosmopolitan ambiance, complimented by a magnificent lounge area, promises to elevate your dining experience.

Kafenio & Deli : A fascinating take on Greece's time-honoured coffee house culture, serving traditional local meze, regional pastries, along with a choice of locally produced cheeses and cold cuts. The offerings are further elevated by homemade pies baked each day.

The Village of Gialova

The beachfront village of Gialova is less than 10 minutes (by car) from the Westin Hotel Costa Navarino, has a beautiful location right on the beach and features a variety of bars and restaurants. A taxi for 4 people from The Westin or Romanos Hotel is approximately 15 euros. If you choose to drive, there is a large gravel car park behind the beach which is free of charge.

Vergos Haunt: This is on the first floor giving you a lovely view of the bay and beach from the terrace. Family owned and operated; it serves traditional Greek food. If you love moussaka or lamb chops, make sure you book a table here. The food is fantastic, and it is amazing value for money.

La Cucina: This Italian restaurant is next to Vergos, overlooking the beach. Ranked number 2 on Trip Advisor, the food and service is excellent. No website available, just a Facebook page.

Carne: This is on the ground floor and has tables outside on the promenade, just a few feet from the beach. As the name suggests, they specialise in fresh meats <https://carnerestaurant.gr/en/home-en/>.

Kochili: In front of the blue of Navarino Bay, you can taste fresh fish, seafood delicacies, delicious local meats and fresh salads.
